

# IMAGINATION CELEBRATION'S ART FOR LIFE Registration Application July 09

Class sizes range from five to twenty students and many of the sessions are presented by a Master Teacher and a Practicing Educator working in concert to give participants individual attention while sharing of their own expertise with the group.



## Pre-K to Kindergarten

Wednesdays – July 8, 15, 22 & 29  
9:00am-11:00am

Each lesson for this class will focus on arts integration with a focus on literature. Each child will be served a theme based snack and encouraged to participate in a class sound story at the end of class.

## Cultures / Grades 1-2

Mondays – July 6, 13, 20 & 27  
1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

Students will study various cultures and discover some of the many exciting traditions, art forms, and stories from these places. One of the countries featured in this series will be Japan. During this session students will learn to count in Japanese, create a children's fish banner, taste green tea prepared in a Japanese tea pot, and learn how to make an origami frog. Each session will be filled with hands on activities and snacks will be provided to represent each culture.

## Constructions / Grades 3-4

Tuesdays – July 7, 14, 21 & 28  
1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

This series will focus on 3 dimensional structures. Students will explore architecture, sculpture and construction using a variety of materials. Students will work with Model Magic, paper, and recycled materials, etc. while learning about balance and how structures are created and why. Students will be served "structural snacks" and work individually and in groups throughout this series.

## Connections / Grades 5-6

Wednesdays – July 8, 15, 22 & 29  
1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

This series will present art in relation to concepts including Math, Social Studies, Science and Language Arts. These classes will provide student with the opportunity to apply the things they are learning in school to fun, hands-on activities. In the Science portion of this series, students will learn about insects, create beautiful 3-D replicas and then design an environment using various materials for their own terrarium environment. Students will be served theme based snacks. Students will participate in drawing, painting, printmaking and sculptural activities.

## Processes / Grades 7-8

Thursdays – July 9, 16, 23 & 30  
1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

This series will focus on various art processes including Drawing, Painting, Printmaking, and Sculpture. Students will be given an opportunity to explore different materials and techniques while exploring artists of the past as well as contemporary artists. During the Printmaking session students will explore, screen printing, mono-printing, as well as marbleizing as well calligraphy. Students will be served theme based snacks.

## Materials / Grades 9-12

Fridays – July 10, 17, 24 & 31  
1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

This special series will explore a variety of materials and applications of artistic principles. Students will work with glass, wire, paper, clay etc. to expand their knowledge of skills and techniques as applied to various materials. Students will develop an individual focus of study after learning about various materials and their care and handling. Only non-toxic items will be used. Students will create a glass fused piece, work with water soluble pastels and explore a variety of collage techniques.
