

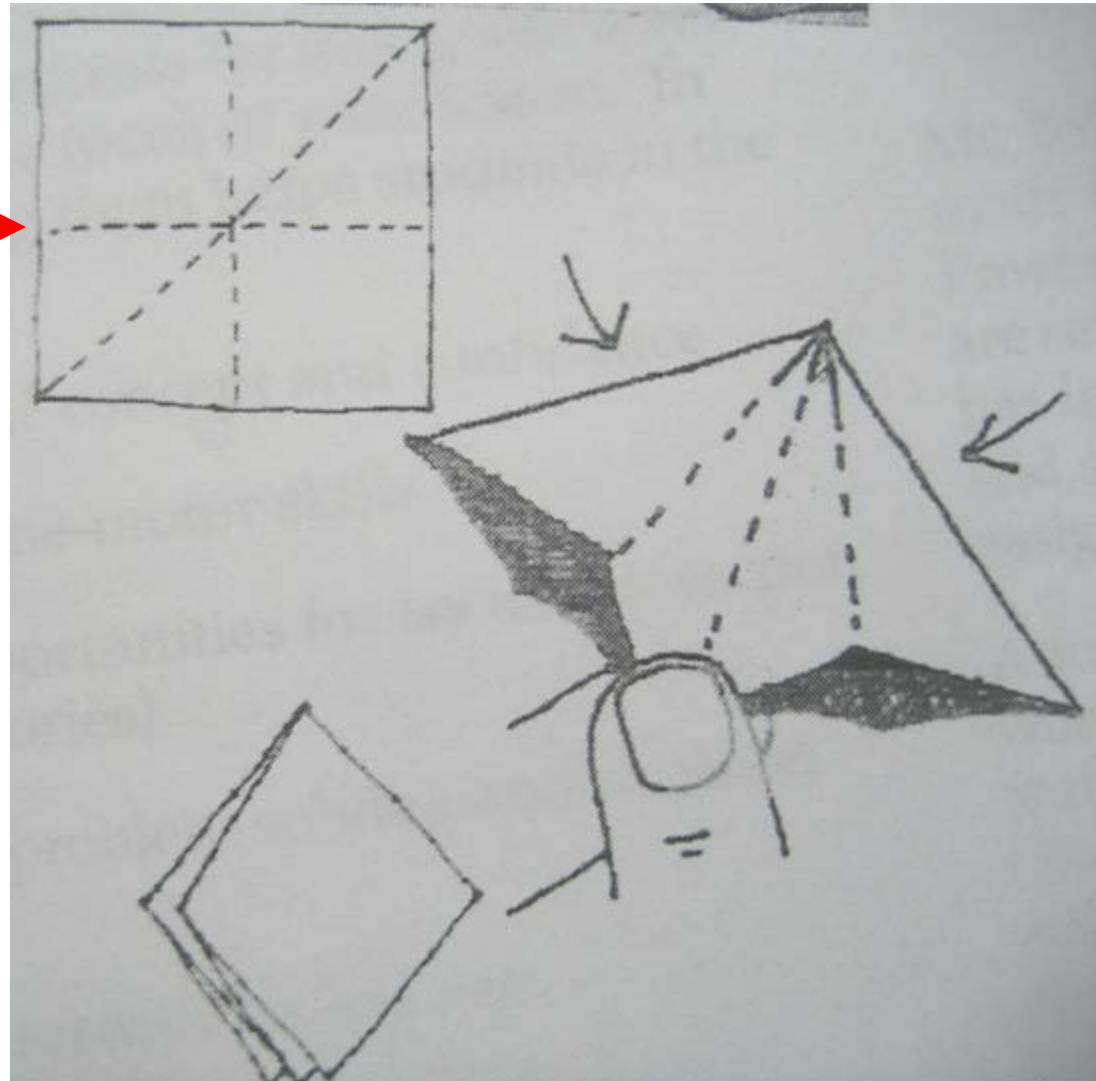
# Bookmaking

# Star Book

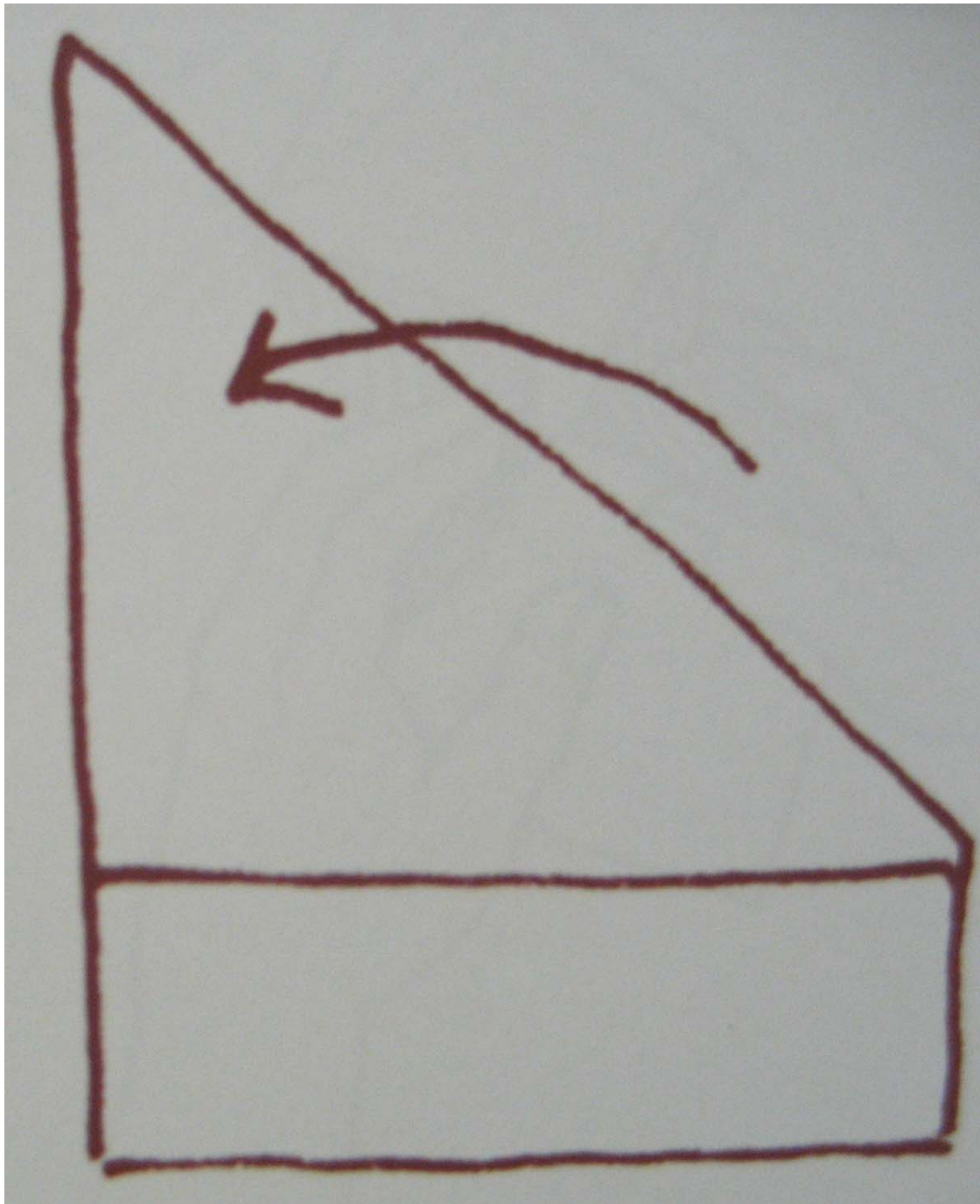


# FOLDS NEEDED for EACH Sheet:

Top-to-bottom  
Left-to-right  
Corner-to-corner

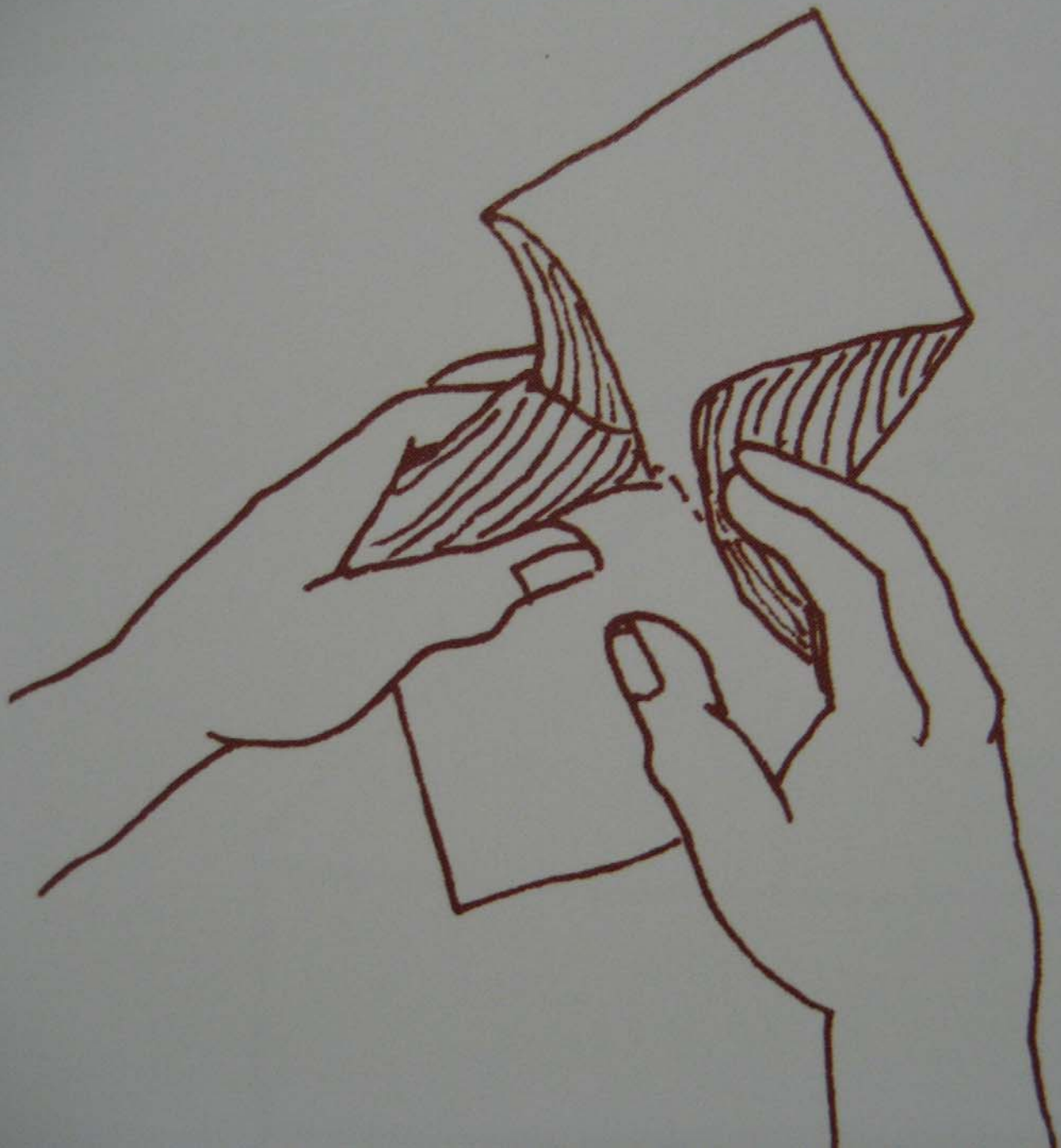


**INVERSE FOLD**  
**EACH SQUARE**  
so that the inner  
triangles tuck inside



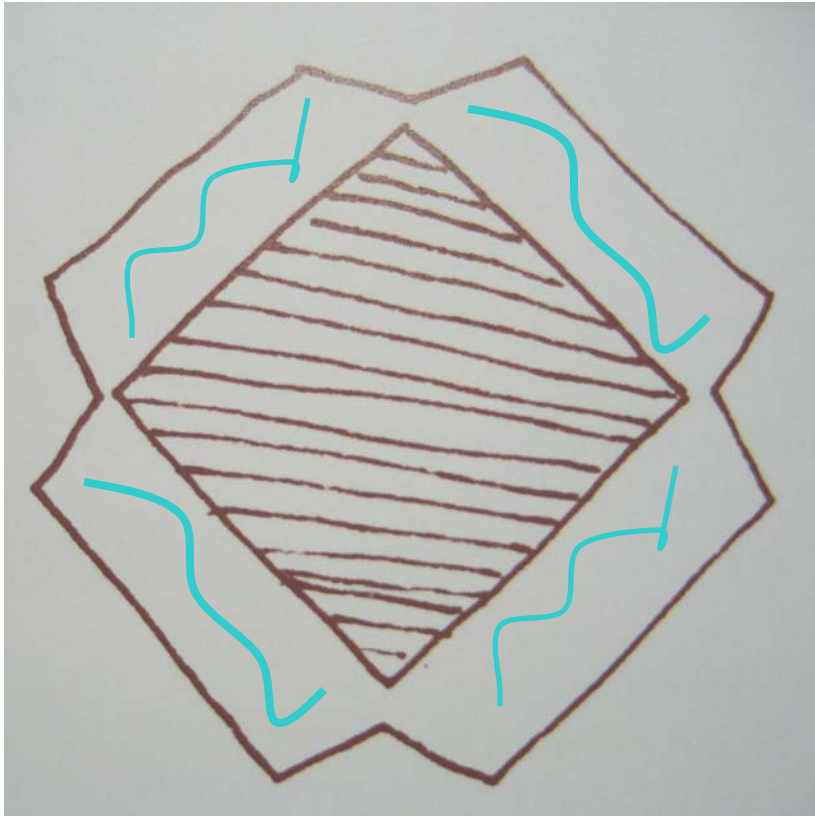
**To Make a  
Square**  
out of a sheet of  
xerox paper,

fold the top  
corner to meet  
the edge of the  
paper.

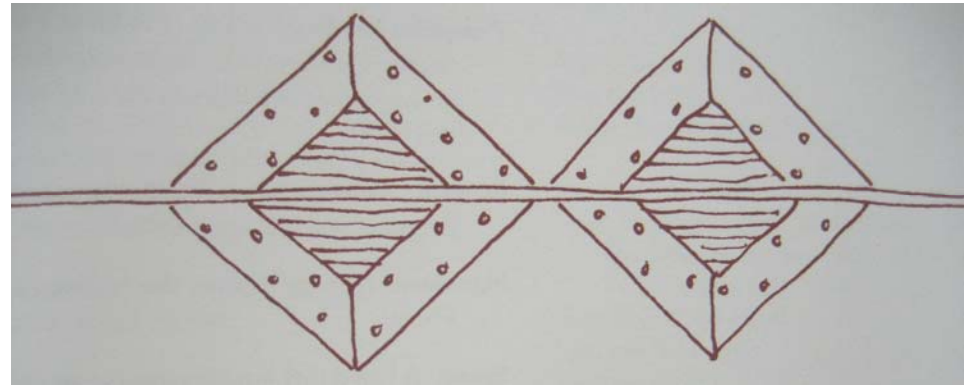


# COVERS

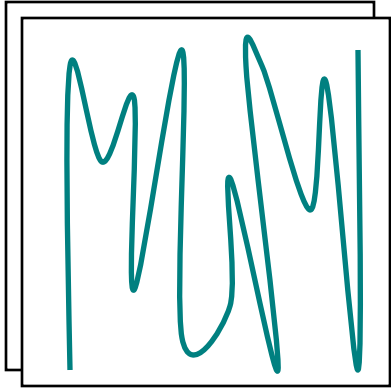
Using a square of cardboard, create TABS to glue and fold around the cardboard neatly.



*Optional: Add Ribbon  
to tie book shut*

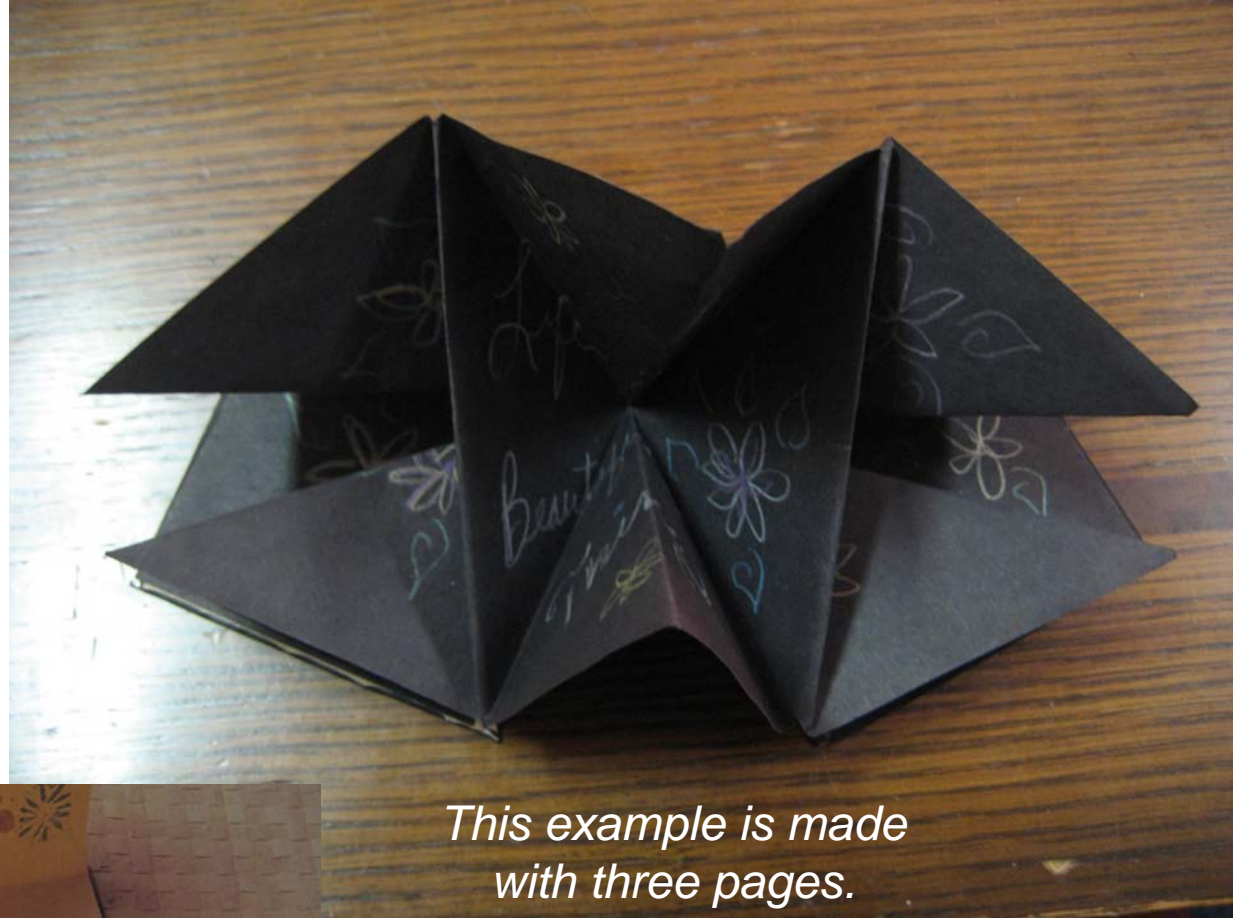


# ADHERING PAGES TO COVER



**Apply** glue to one folded structure.

**Stack** the next folded structure, aligning the square's edges.

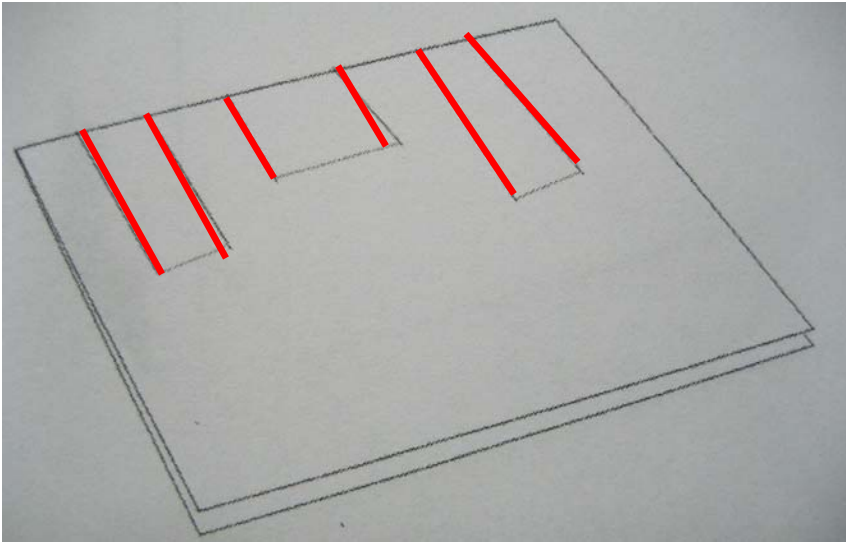


*This example is made with three pages.*



**Attach** the **outer squares** to the previously formed cardboard covers with glue.

# Basic Pop Up Folds



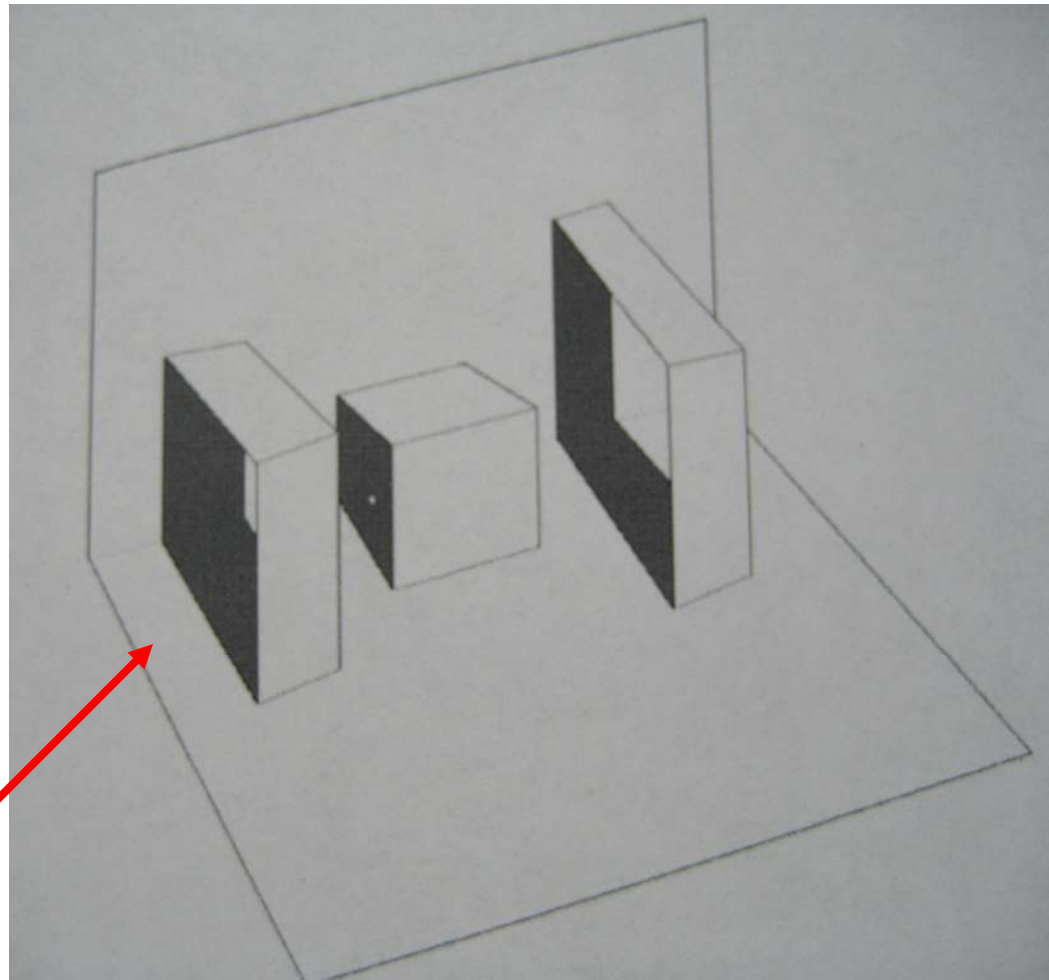
On a sheet of paper, folded in half...

Draw pairs of lines that are **perpendicular** to the crease.

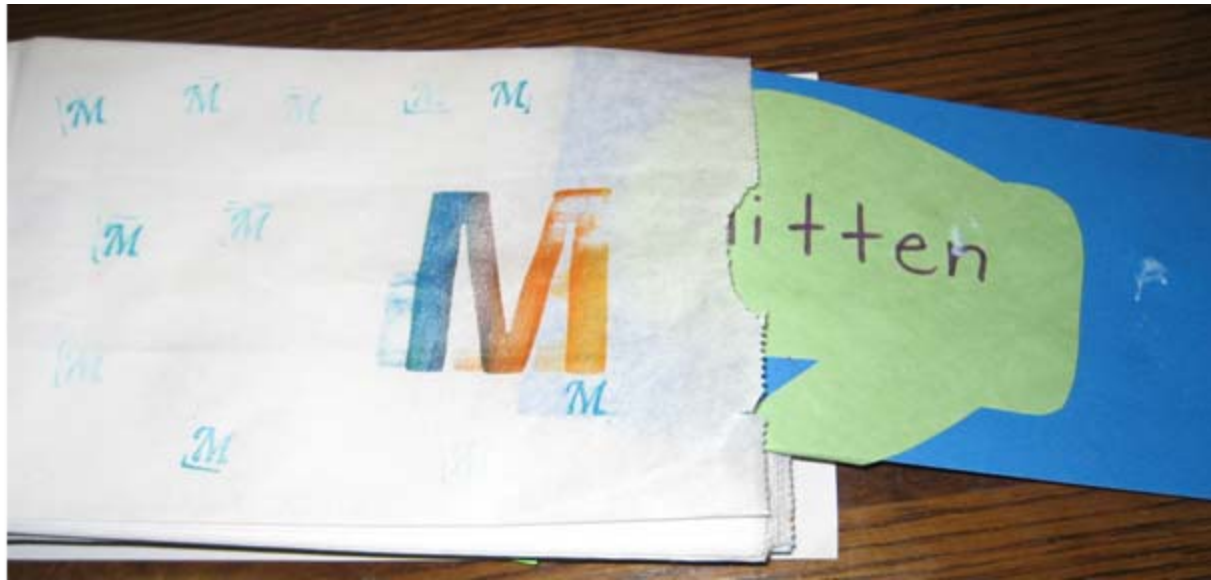
*HINT: Be sure that the line is less than half the width of the folded paper.*

After cutting each line, fold each rectangle forward.

Open the card and INVERSE the fold.



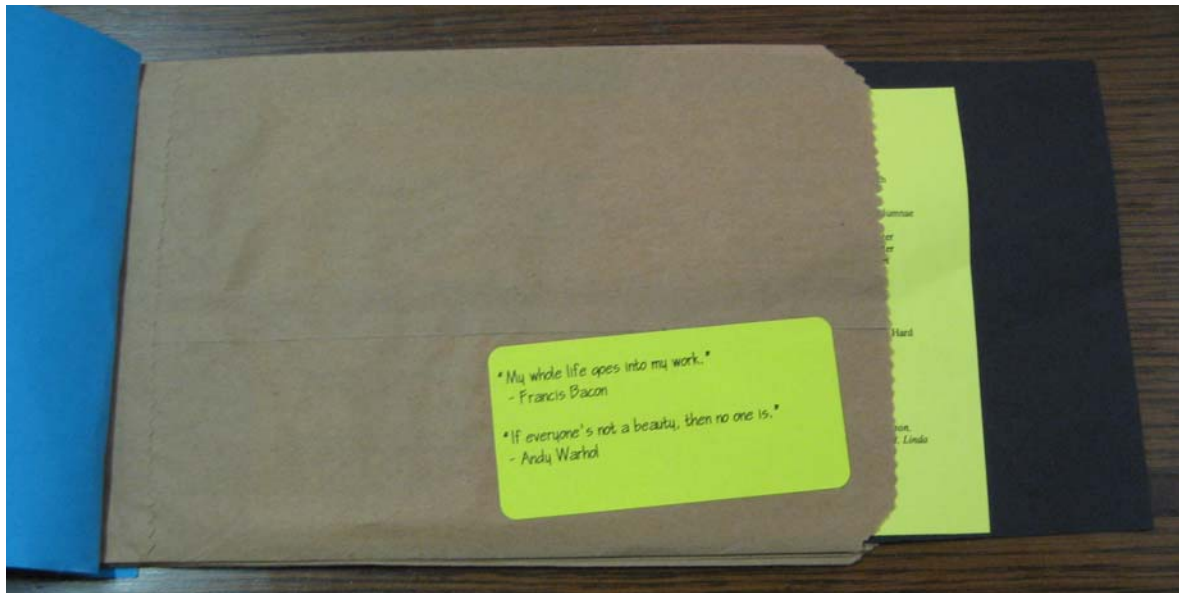
# Paper Bag Book



Bind multiple paper bags using staples or punch-holes along the closed edge of the bag.

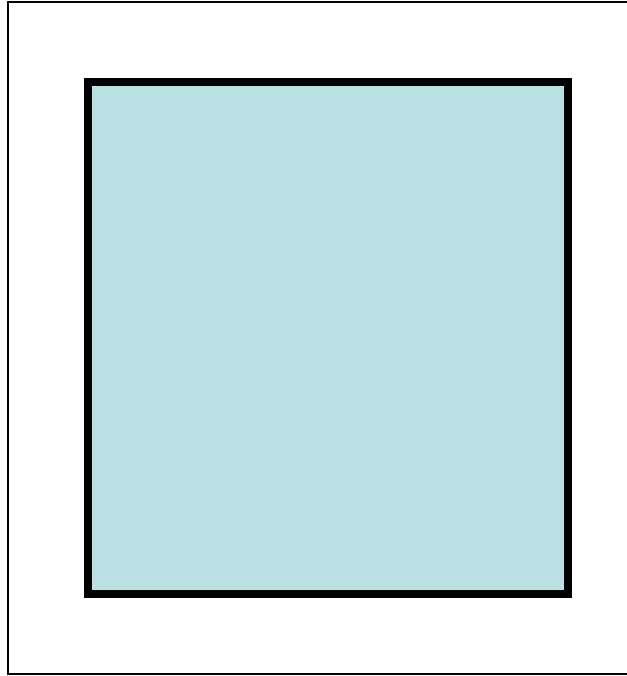
Utilize the opening of the bag to slide custom-sized paper into the book.

*These additions are removable.*

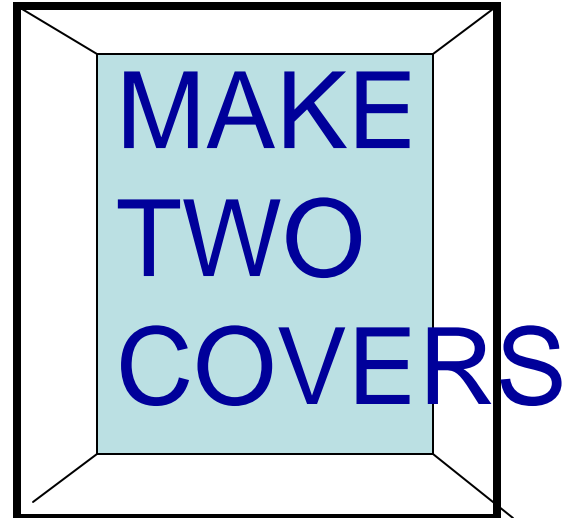
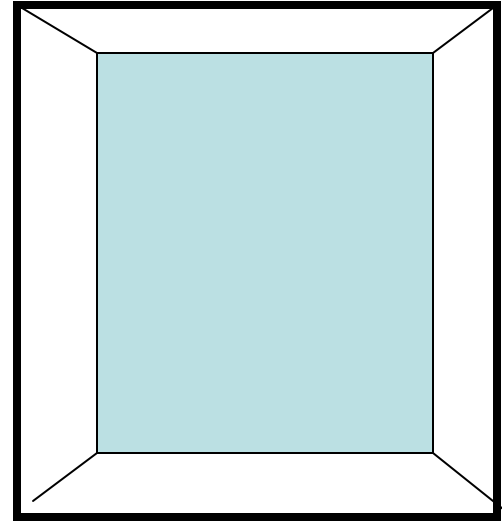
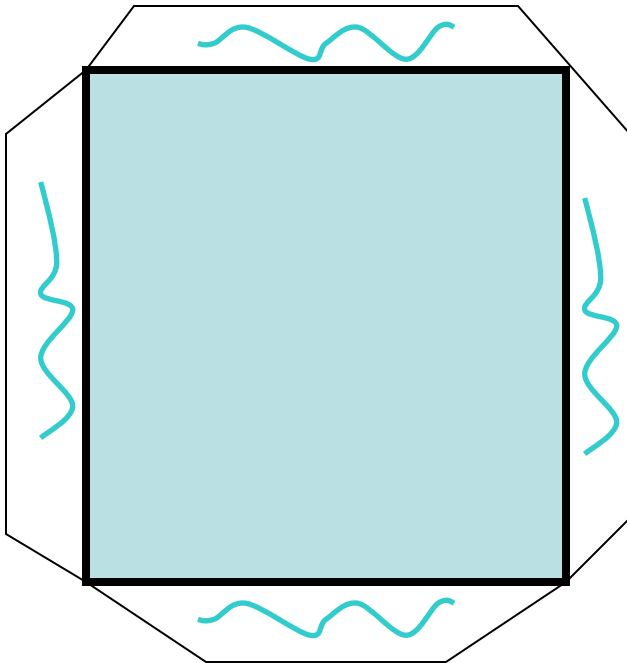


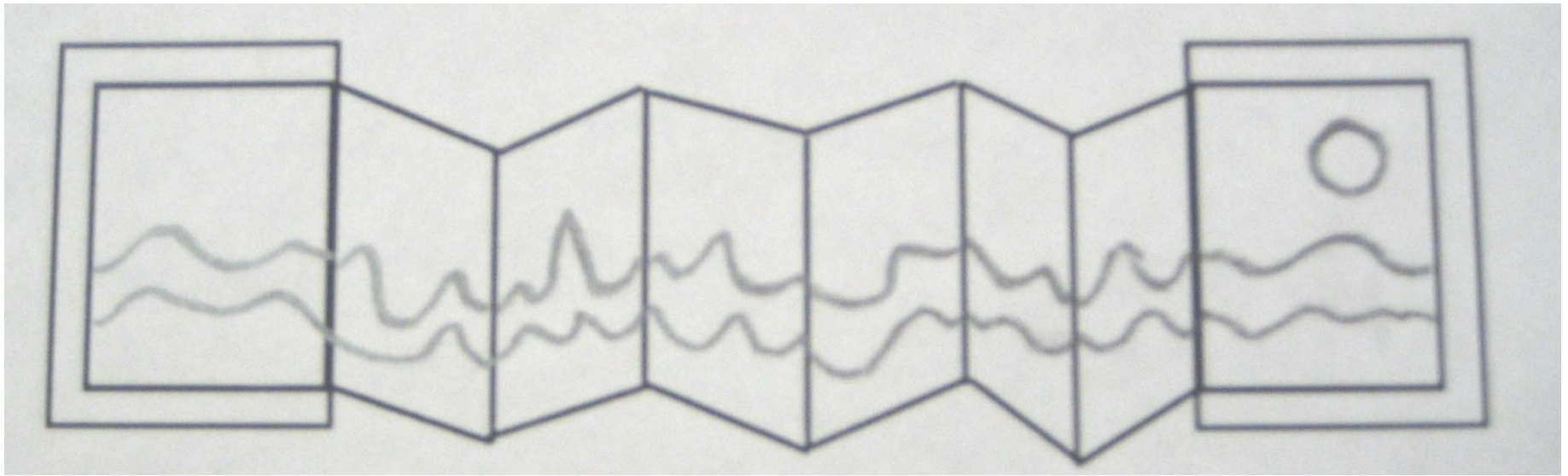
# Accordion Book

Glue cardboard to a sheet of decorative paper.



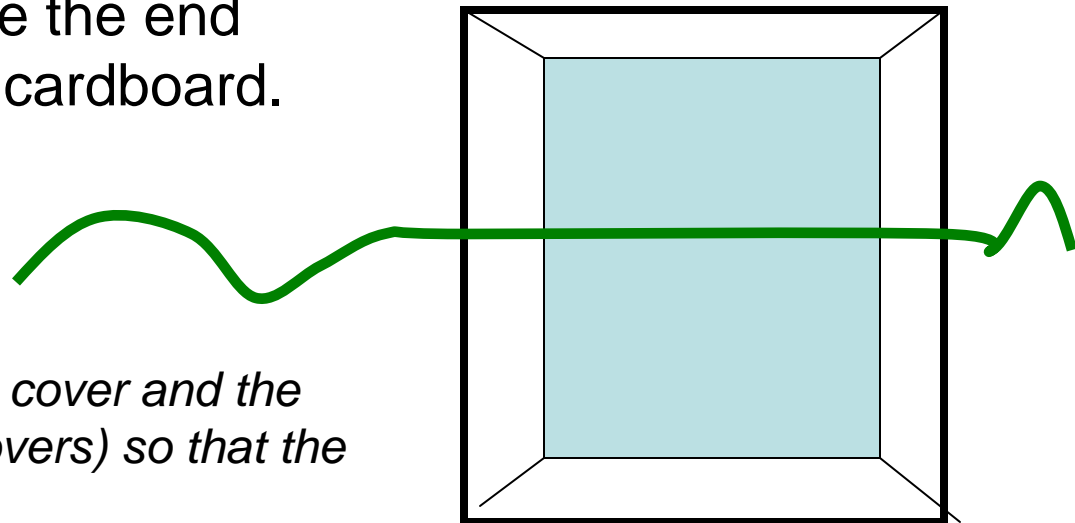
Next, miter the corner of the decorative paper. Glue and tightly fold each tab.



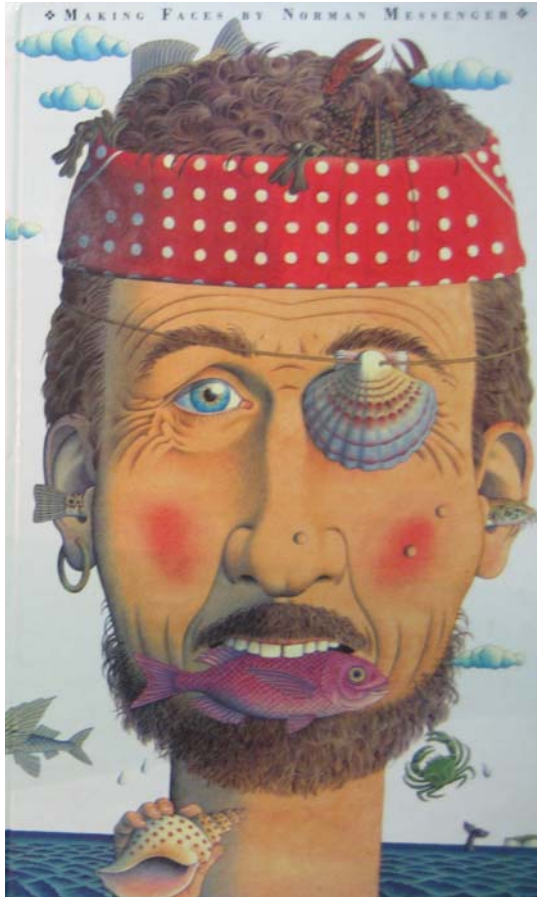


Insert a sheet of paper that is accordion folded into the two covers: glue the end rectangles onto each piece of cardboard.

*OPTIONAL: Use ribbon between the cover and the accordion folded paper (on BOTH covers) so that the book ties shut.*

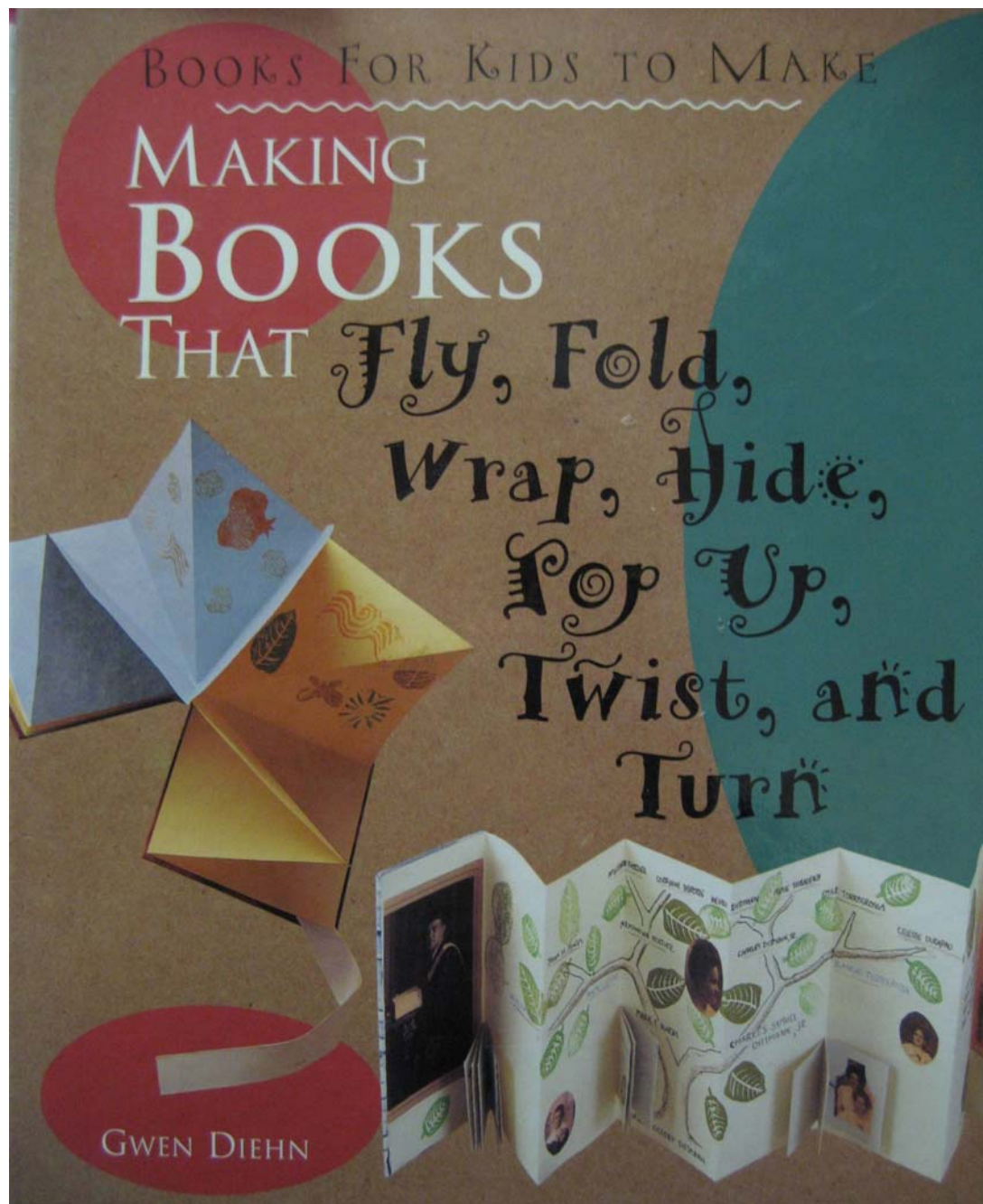
